If-Satz	Hauptsatz
1. <u>Irreales</u> Bedingungsgefüge auf die <u>Vergangenheit</u> bezogen (Typ 3) ==> „Was wäre gewesen, wenn ...“	
Nicht erfüllte Bedingung <i>If I had had the money, If you had come earlier, If I had not lost my money,</i> ==> past perfect	Nur gedachte Folge <i>I would have helped him. You would have met my uncle from America. I could have bought a present for her.</i> ==> would, could + have + past participle
2.* <u>Irreales</u> Bedingungsgefüge auf die <u>Vergangenheit</u> und die <u>Gegenwart</u> bezogen ==> Mischformen	
Nicht erfüllbare Bedingung (in der Gegenwart) <i>If I was/were still 20 years old, If I had enough money,</i> ==> past tense	Nur gedachte Folge (in der Vergangenheit) <i>I would have made a trip to Australia last month. I would/could have bought that Ferrari yesterday.</i> ==> would, could + have + past participle
Nicht erfüllte Bedingung (in der Vergangenheit) <i>If I had not lost my money yesterday, If Kane had scored last Saturday,</i> ==> past perfect	Nur gedachte Folge (in der Gegenwart) <i>I would/could buy an ice-cream now. Bayern would be Champion now..</i> ==> would, could + infinitive
